Service is at the heart of Christianity. When Jesus said "...whoever would be great among you must be your servant, and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all", he redefined what it means leadership and greatness. He also set a course for his followers. We are to be servants of one another and of all, including those who do not follow Christ or who may not like us, even our enemies. Jesus went on to say "For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" and these were not empty words. He washed the disciples' feet at the last supper. He fed the 5000 when he was tired and wanted to be alone with his disciples. He healed many again and again. He especially served us as he gave "his life as a ransom for many" by dying in our place on the cross.

The problem is that we don't always want to serve. This may be because we want to be served or that we feel it is beneath us to serve some people. It may be because we have served in the past and either had a bad experience or think that we have done our time and others need to serve now. We may also just be burned out.

The truth is that there is no end to serving. We are to be servants as long as we are alive. However, balance is the key as in all of Christianity. If we serve in everything, we usually are not as effective and may burn out. Also, we may remove the opportunity for others to serve by doing it all ourselves.

Finding where to serve takes prayer, but also open eyes and ears. We need to see the need, but also to listen for requests. We need to consider if this is where God would have us serve as well as if we should give up other service as we take up a new one. We do want to use our gifts, but also need to consider that God will equip us as he calls us to new service. In the end, it is about loving others and doing our Father's work as his children. Besides, that's what it means to be great and to be a follower of Christ.
