ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN – IMMEDIATE UKRAINE
REFUGEE RELIEF In an unprecedented effort to rush humanitarian aid to refugees fleeing Ukraine, Orphan Grain Train—Michigan is mounting an immediate shipment of supplies. With the generous support of Countryside Transportation Service of Sebewaing, a semi-trailer of relief

will depart by next weekend. Goods will be taken to Nebraska for intended air-cargo transport to Poland now flooded with over a million desperate families and children. Orphan Grain Train--Michigan is calling for specific items to be included with this shipment. Diapers, Powdered baby formula, New socks, New underwear, Powdered detergent, Hygiene items such as sanitary products, toothbrushes, adult diapers, towels and washcloths, and bar soap.
